

**ANNOUNCEMENT AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE OF THE NATIONAL
ELECTORAL COMMISSION HELD ON
8 JUNE 2009 AT 2.30CET AT THE NEC'S HEADQUARTERS.**

On 8 June 2009 at 2:30CET a press conference concerning the European Parliament Elections 2009 was held at the headquarters of the National Electoral Commission.

During the conference, NEC's member, Judge Jan Kacprzak announced the first partial unofficial results of the vote and the forecasted distribution of mandates in the elections to the European Parliament as at 2:13CET on 8 June 2009.

On the basis of the data received electronically from 5362 local electoral commissions out of the total number of 25605 commissions, i.e. 20,94%, the partial unofficial results of the election with regard to the number of votes cast on lists of individual electoral committees and a forecasted distribution of mandates between electoral committees, determined on the basis of the data from those commissions is as follows:

Number of eligible voters: 5 789 809;

Number of voters who participated in the election: 1 307 884;

Turnout: 22,59%;

Number of valid votes cast on all constituency lists in the country: 1 282 294;

Number of valid votes cast on individual constituency lists was as follows:
