

**ANNOUNCEMENT AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE OF THE NATIONAL
ELECTORAL COMMISSION HELD ON
8 JUNE 2009 AT 5:10 CET AT THE NEC'S HEADQUARTERS.**

On 8 June 2009 at 5:10CET a press conference concerning the European Parliament Elections 2009 was held at the headquarters of the National Electoral Commission.

During the press conference, NEC's member, Judge Jan Kacprzak announced partial unofficial results of the vote and the forecasted distribution of mandates in the elections to the European Parliament as at 5:00CET on 8 June 2009.

On the basis of the data received electronically from 18447 polling stations out of the total number of 25605 polling stations, i.e. 72,04%, the partial unofficial results of the election with regard to the number of votes cast on lists of individual electoral committees and a forecasted distribution of mandates between electoral committees, determined on the basis of the data from those commissions are as follows:

Number of eligible voters: 21 335 659;

Number of voters who participated in the election: 5 010 343;

Turnout: 23,48%;

Number of valid votes cast on all constituency lists in the country: 4 916 216;

Number of valid votes cast on individual constituency lists was as follows:
